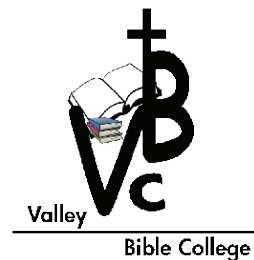


## Valley Bible College offers a Diploma in Biblical and Theological Studies

# Valley Bible College Diploma in Biblical and Theological Studies



## Course Requirements

### BASIC THEOLOGY - 101 (Level 1)

A survey of theology featuring a comprehensive study of the major doctrines of the Bible. Doctrines included in this course are the Bible, the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit, Man, Satan, Angels, Demons, Salvation, Sin, the Church and Future Events. The Student at the end of this course will better understand what they believe and more importantly, why they believe it.

### NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY - 102 (Level 1)

A chronological and comprehensive survey of the New Testament books of Matthew through Revelation. This course focuses on questions dealing with authorship, date, sources, purpose audience, etc. It ensures that the New Testament books will be accurately understood within their historical settings.



### OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY - 103 (Level 1)

A study of the Pentateuch, including the major characters and events. Special attention is given to the Patriarchs, the events of the Exodus, and the Tabernacle. A chronological study of Israel's history from Joshua to the closing of the Old Testament. Emphasis is given to major characters and themes of books.

### ACTS / EVANGELISM - 104 (Level 1)

An exposition of Acts, concentrating on the history of the spread of the gospel in the early Church. This course is also designed to equip each student with a Biblical understanding of the task of winning souls to the Lord Jesus Christ. A careful study of the methods of personal evangelism is undertaken.

### CHURCH HISTORY - 201 (Level 2) \*\*prereq

This course is designed to provide the student with an overview of the major events in the life of the church from its birth to the present age.

### CHURCH LEADERSHIP - 202 (Level 2) \*\*prereq

This course is for anyone who wants the church to be what God intended it to be. In this class you will learn how to apply the lesson Moses learned from Jethro and to follow Paul's example of building a strong ministry team.

### DANIEL - 203 (Level 2) \*\*prereq

An introduction to and exposition of Daniel, concentration on its historical background and prophetic contribution.

### JOHN - 204 (Level 2) \*\*prereq

A thorough investigation of the fourth Gospel, highlighting the person and work of Jesus Christ.

### HERMENEUTICS - 301 (Level 3) \*\*prereq

A study of the principles of sound Biblical interpretation concerning the books of the Bible based on the historical, geographical, grammatical and contextual method.

### CULTS - 302 (Level 3) \*\*prereq

This course includes a careful study of the major cults of our day. A verse by verse analysis of the Bible passages, which are misused to teach false doctrine is provided.

### REVELATION - 303 (Level 3) \*\*prereq

A comprehensive study of the apocalypse. Particular emphasis is given to understanding the correct method of interpreting the book. Current economic, political, and social trends on the world stage are noted as they seem to be pointing toward the rapidly approaching fulfillment of much of the prophecy of the book.



### MINOR PROPHETS - 304 (Level 3) \*\*prereq

A study of the messages of the minor prophets and their prophetic and doctrinal significance.

### HOMILETICS/PUBLIC SPEAKING - 401 (Level 4)

\*\*prereq

**Homeiletics:(men)** A course in preparation of expository sermons. Emphasis is on mastering an effective sermon building track for preaching through a book of the Bible.

**Public Speaking:(ladies)** This course is designed to help the student speak effectively before others. The student will experience classroom instruction and practical participation in speech delivery, readings, and evaluations.

### MAJOR PROPHETS - 402 (Level 4) \*\*prereq

A study of the major prophets, their circumstances and reasons for writing. Emphasis is placed on features of Old Testament Christology as given through the prophets.

### MISSIONS - 403 (Level 4) \*\*prereq

An advanced course dealing with the philosophy of world evangelization. Particular attention is given to the misconceptions of missions, qualifications of the missionary, the call and methodology.

### ROMANS - 404 (Level 4) \*\*prereq

An introduction to and exposition of Romans noting man's condemnation because of sin and his justification and sanctification because of the work of Christ.

#### \*\* Prerequisites

All levels must be completed before moving on to the next level of study. Exceptions may be made if you have previous Bible School courses.
